Your Event Manager is your planning partner through game day. They will help you determine the right length of time for your event, create your Zoom link, and add the company logo to the virtual felt.

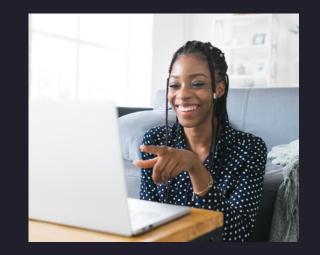
On game day, you are in the very capable hands of your Tournament Director and poker dealers. Their job is to execute the plan and get your employees into the action.

#### What to expect on Game Day

- We will open the Zoom call early so you can meet the staff before guests arrive.
- Doors open and our dealers will show everyone how to get on our site. Players choose a fun avatar and make up a cool poker nickname.
- Lessons are available prior to the tournament to help nervous rookies feel comfortable. Don't worry, cheat sheets included! When its game time we will shine the light on you for opening remarks.
- The tournament begins with "Shuffle Up and Deal". Players start with enough chips to ensure everyone gets plenty of play. Your company logo is right on the table.
- During the game tables will consolidate creating a different social dynamic and allowing folks to play with a variety of people.
- Players who get knocked out are encouraged to join a Second Chance tournament or socialize with players on different tables.



#### FAQ's

- Does this cost money? Our platform is a "play money" site. Companies pay us to host a game based on the number of tables needed. Players do not buy chips at any time.
- Is there an app or something to download? We are 100% browser based. Nothing to download.
- How do players see each other? Each game is paired with video conferencing, allowing guests to communicate in real time. Players simply open one browser window for their video call and a second one to join our site. We prefer Zoom but can work with Webex, Teams, and Meet.
- Does Zoom get loud or crowded? It is very festive in the beginning when players are checking in but once the game starts we use a separate breakout room for each table.
- What do the dealers do? The computer controls the game, but every table has a live dealer to answer questions, announce the action, and keep everyone engaged. We consider them "Poker Ambassadors."
- How long is the event? Games average 90 minutes but can be scheduled to meet your needs.
- How many players can participate? We currently can host up to 250 at once. For larger events we will often schedule multiple games to accommodate everyone.
- When are you available? We like to say, "Anytime, any time zone".
